


BOARD OF EDUCATION
CLAYTON MUNICIPAL SCHOOL DISTRICT #1
February 7, 2019
6:00 P.M.

The work session of the Board of Education, Clayton Municipal School District #1, was called to order by President Riley in the High School Cafeteria at 6:25 P.M. on Thursday, February 7, 2019.

There were eight sub-groups including students, teachers, support staff, business community, general support individuals, parents, board and administrators and community members present at the Needs Assessment workshop in the Clayton High School Cafeteria. All were encouraged to participate in activities lead by David Chavez in identifying needs in the District. Sixty-seven (67) recommendations were identified as potential needs for the district. The attendees were then divided into the identified peer sub-groups and asked to prioritize the stated needs. Instructions were given to the groups to prioritize the stated needs so that 67 points were distributed. 24 needs were to receive two points (high ranking), 22 needs were to receive one point (average ranking), and twenty-one needs were to receive zero points (low ranking). Nineteen (19) of the items were identified as having strong interest as indicated by the peer groups. The peer groups were grouped once again to provide representation of each sub-group. The newly formed groups reviewed the nineteen items and reprioritized the most important items needing to be addressed.


Results were compiled by David Chavez and will be presented back to CMS board at a later date.
