## THE PROBLEMS:

### **ALVIS ELEMENTARY**

- Security is inadequate
- **Playgrounds** do not meet insurance and safety requirements
- **Exterior paving, walkways, and ramps** are uneven, dangerous and not ADA compliant
- **Staff & visitor restrooms are not ADA compliant**
- **Building systems**, including heating, cooling, plumbing, electrical, and technology need renewal for reliability and to support the classroom environment
- **Windows and exterior doors leak and are not well insulated**
- **Roof is leaking and beyond life expectancy**

### **CLAYTON JR HIGH SCHOOL**

- Security is inadequate
- Restrooms are not ADA compliant

### **CLAYTON HIGH SCHOOL**

- Security is inadequate
- **Exterior paving, walkways, and ramps** are uneven, dangerous and not ADA compliant
- **Restrooms are not ADA compliant**
- **Building systems**, including heating, cooling, plumbing, electrical, and technology need renewal for reliability and to support the classroom environment
- **Windows and exterior doors leak** and are not well insulated causing student and staff discomfort
- **Roof is leaking and does not drain well**

## BOND PROPOSAL:

### **DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENTS**

- **Remodeling existing school buildings and grounds** in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- **Remodeling existing school buildings** to include new doors and windows, painting, and other renovations extending the useful life of existing schools
- **Furnishing existing school buildings** with updated security systems to protect our students
- **Improving and upgrade elementary school playground equipment and high school grounds** to meet insurance and ADA compliance
- **Repair/Replace outdated leaking roofs**

### **ESTIMATED MILL LEVY IMPACT**

The average mill levy for the bonds will be 4.6 mills, which equates to \$4.60 per \$1000 of taxable value.

**An investment of \$12.75/month or \$153/year per \$100,000 home's actual value funds \$7.95 million in school facility improvements.**

## *First-Time Registrants*

If you are registering for the first time in New Mexico, and you submit the registration form by mail, then you must submit with the form a copy of (1) a current and valid photo identification; or (2) a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, student identification card or other government document, including identification issued by an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo that shows your name and current address. If you do not submit one of these forms of identification with your mailed-in, first-time registration, then you would be required to present one of the forms of identification when voting in person or absentee.
